

Three years later (two years for DPP)



You are eligible for a licence review THREE years after your first release from prison or TWO years after if you received a DPP (regardless of recalls).



In Prison

If you are in prison on recall at the three-year (two-year for DPP) eligibility point, your release **AND** your licence will be decided at your next Parole hearing. The Parole Board may decide to:

- · Keep you in prison
- · Release you on licence
- · Release you with no licence (very unlikely)




If you are in the community at the three-year (two year for DPP) eligibility point the Parole Board will hold a hearing to decide whether to:

- · Leave your licence in place
- · Vary your licence conditions
- · Remove your licence



No change to Licence

If your licence is left in place – you must serve a further **two** years in the community without any recalls or new offences.



If the Parole Board decides to remove your licence your IPP sentence will end.

No change to Licence

If you are released and your licence is left in place – you must serve a further **two** years in the community without any recalls or new offences.

If you are recalled

If you are recalled to prison within the two-year period, the clock will **RESTART** and you will still need to serve two years on licence from the point of re-release. The Secretary of State has the power to stop recalls counting against the two-year period if they believe it is appropriate to do so but this is likely to be used sparingly.

If you stay in the community

If you stay in the community for a further two years without any recalls or new offences your IPP sentence will end.

If you are recalled

If you are recalled to prison within the two-year period, the clock will **RESTART** and you will still need to serve two years on licence from the point of re-release. The Secretary of State has the power to stop recalls counting against the two-year period if they believe it is appropriate to do so but this is likely to be used sparingly.
